## REGULATIONS

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which shall be used should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

### Article 1 – Organisation

The Competition, which has the status of an International Competition, shall be run in conformity with:

- the International Sporting Code ("the Code") and its Appendices,
- the National Sporting Code where applicable,
- the official FIA Bulletins,
- the General Prescriptions applicable to International Hill Climb Competitions
- the Sporting Regulations of the FIA European Hill Climb Championship ("the Sporting Regulations"), and
- these Supplementary Regulations.

In case of withdrawal for reasons of force majeure (no-show for administrative checking and scrutineering) after the publication of the list of entries, 50% of the base entry fees shall be reimbursed to the Competitor(s), subject to receipt of a written request.

**Article 3 – Eligible cars – Groups and Categories****3.1 Category 1 – Production cars:**

The Competition is open to cars holding a national technical passport and complying with the prescriptions of FIA Appendix J (unless otherwise indicated) for the following groups:

<b>Group N</b>	Production cars, including Group R1.
<b>Group A</b>	Touring cars, including World Rally Cars, Super 1600 and cars from Groups R2 and R3.
<b>Group S20</b>	Super 2000 cars (Circuit and Rally combined), including Groups R4 and R5.
<b>Group GT</b>	Grand Touring cars (GT3 and RGT combined).

**3.2 Category 2 – Competition cars:**

The Competition is open to cars holding a national technical passport and complying with the prescriptions of FIA Appendix J (unless otherwise indicated) for the following groups:

<b>Group D/E2-SS (Single-seater)</b>	International Formula or Free Formula single-seater racing cars with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm <sup>3</sup> or below.
<b>Group CN</b>	Two-seater production sports cars, open or closed, with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm <sup>3</sup> or below.
<b>Group E2-SC (Sports car)</b>	Two-seater racing cars, open or closed, with a cylinder capacity of 3000cm <sup>3</sup> or below.
<b>Group E2-SH (Silhouette)</b>	Cars having the appearance of a large production road car with at least 2 seats and the same shaped windscreen as this car. Cylinder capacity 6500cm <sup>3</sup> or below.

#### Article 6 – Insurance

In accordance with legal requirements, the Organiser has taken out one or more insurance policies against the following risks:

- Third Party Insurance in the amount of 500 000,00 PLN (€114 942,00 approx.) for the event.

- Accident insurance - coverage in the event of permanent damage to the health of 15 000 PLN (€3448 approx.) for members of the organizer personnel.





The Organiser's third party insurance is valid for the entire duration of the Competition, not only during official practice and race heats but also for travelling from the parking area to the course of the Competition and back.

#### Article 7 – Protests and appeals

Protest fee: €300 (1300 PLN).

Appeal fee set by the ASN: €580 (2500 PLN).

International appeal fee (FIA): €6000.

Any protest must be lodged in accordance with the prescriptions of the Code. Protests must be made in writing and given to the clerk of the course or to his assistant, or in their absence to a steward, accompanied by the requisite protest fees.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of various parts of a car, the claimant must also pay a deposit which shall be set by the stewards.

Competitors have the right to appeal, as established in Articles 15.1 to 15.4 of the Code and as provided for in the regulations of the International Court of Appeal.

#### Article 8 – Podium, Prizes and Awards:

The classifications shall be established and shall entail the distribution by the Organiser of awards and cash prizes as follows:

##### 8.2 Special prizes

##### 8.3

a) Prizes shall be awarded regardless of the number of Drivers who take the start.

b) All trophies and cash prizes are cumulative and may be combined with one another and with other prizes awarded by the Organisers in the other jointly-organised Competitions.

##### c) Awarding of prizes:

- Trophies are awarded during the Podium Ceremony.
- Cash prizes must be collected during the Podium Ceremony or from the following location:  
Location: Competition Secretariat "School Complex No. 1" – Stara Wieś.  
Time: 45 minutes after 2<sup>nd</sup> race heat to 105 minutes after 2<sup>nd</sup> race heat, failing which they shall be retained by the Organiser.

#### Article 9 – Additional provisions by the Organiser

9.1 All documents deposited with the Competition Secretariat may be collected by competitors in Parc Fermé after the last race heat. Withdrawn competitors must collect documents from the Competition Secretariat. In the case of non collected documents, the Organiser will return the documents for a fee of 100 PLN (€23 approx.) transferred to the Competition Secretariats bank account.

9.2 In special justified cases the organiser will allow additional administrative checks and scrutineering after 19:30 on 14.07.2017 for an additional 300 PLN (€70 approx) payment.

9.3 The dates and place of subsequent stewards meetings will be established at the first meeting and will be published on the official notice board.

9.4 At all times during the Competition the maximum speed limit inside the Service Park is 30 km/h. Any breach of the speed limit, by the competitor/driver and/or his team personnel and/or his accompanying persons, within the confines of the Service Park, will



be treated as an offence and a penalty will be imposed according to the Stewards decision.

**9.5** All the competitors/drivers are required to use a protective sheet under their cars, to prevent damage and pollution of the ground by petroleum-derived materials.

**9.6** All competitors are obliged to keep a fire extinguisher, with min. of 4 kg of extinguishing agent, within immediate reach of their service positions.

**9.7** Each competitor/driver who attends the Awards ceremony is obliged to present him/herself clothed in the appropriate Motor Sport outfit with overalls buttoned/zippered and with the correct footwear. In addition competitors and their Team members are obliged to behave in a proper manner during the Award Ceremony.

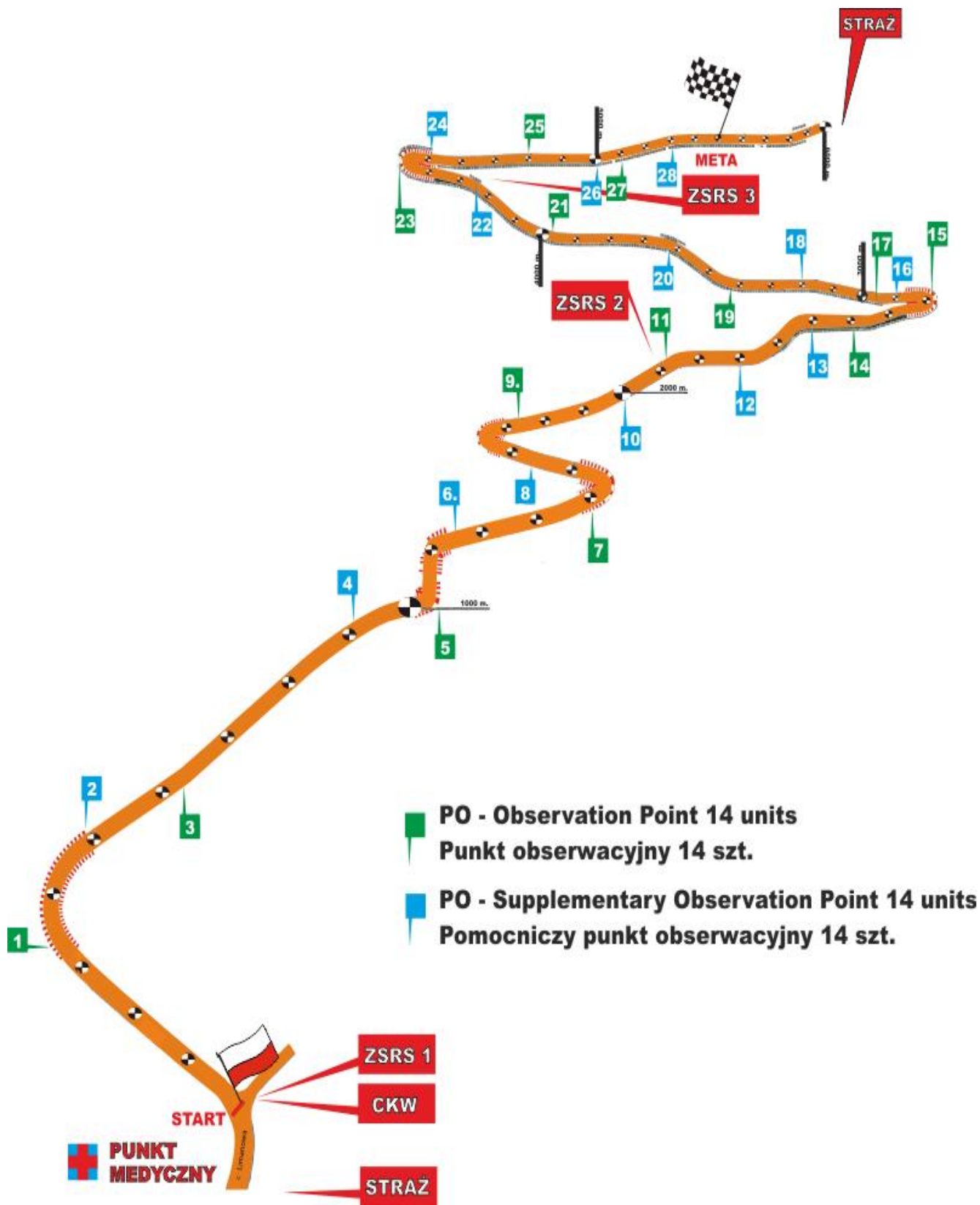
